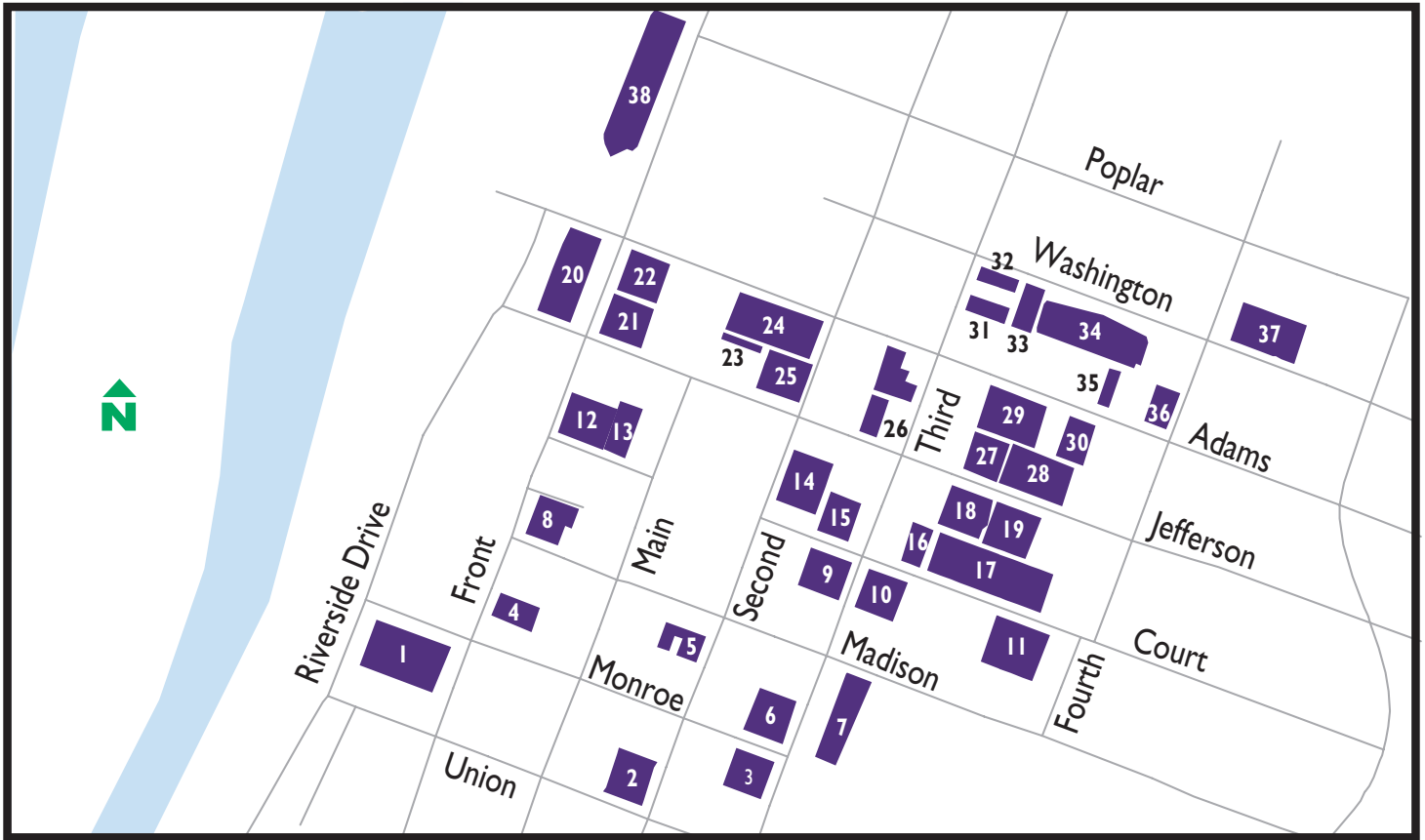

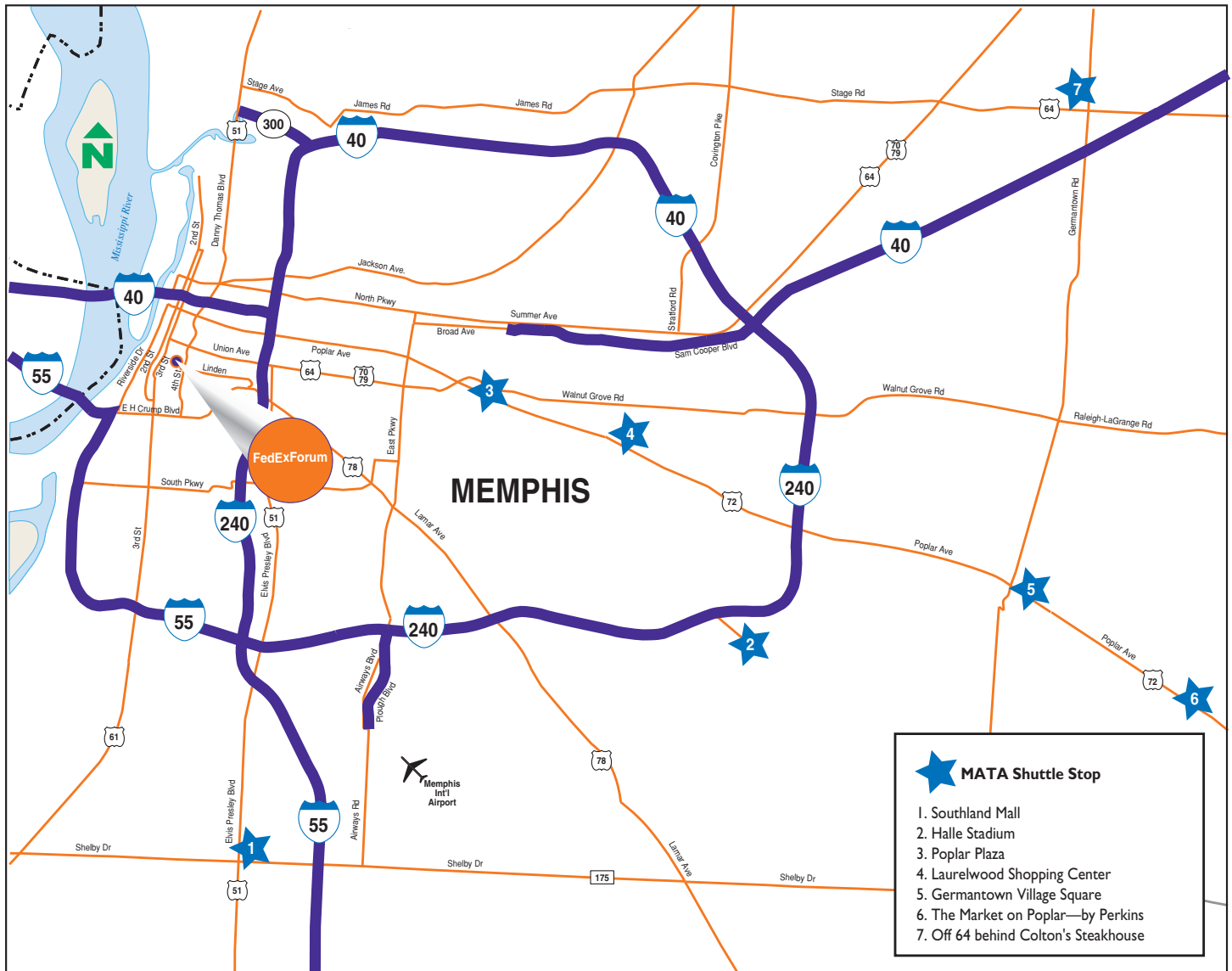

As you prepare to visit FedExForum, please consider these tips from the Memphis Police Department special event traffic experts.

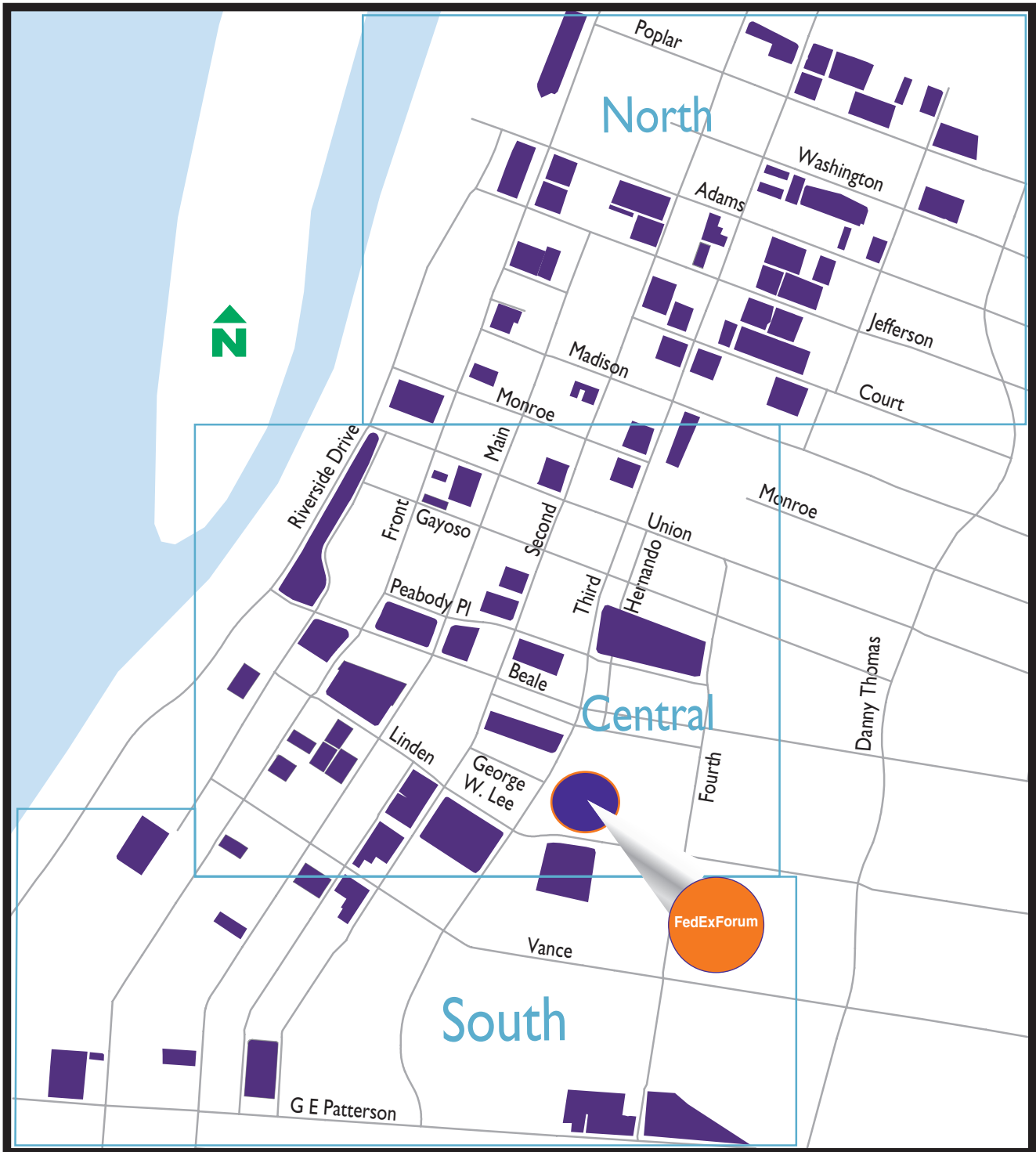
Suggested Routes: From the South, I-55 to E. H. Crump Boulevard to Third Street; I-55/I-240 to Third Street; I-240 Midtown to Lamar to Somerville north to Linden; from the North, I-40 to Second Street south or I-40 to Danny Thomas south; from the East, Poplar to Second Street or Central to Lamar to Somerville to Linden; from the West, I-40 to Riverside or Front Street or I-55 to Riverside or Crump.

Dos: If you approach from the north, park in garages and lots north of FedExForum. If you approach from south, park in garages and lots south and west of FedExForum.

Don'ts: To avoid bottlenecks, congestion and frustration avoid Riverside Drive, where construction has lanes closed, Union Avenue, where utility construction is set this fall, and Main Street, where trolleys and carriages impede traffic.

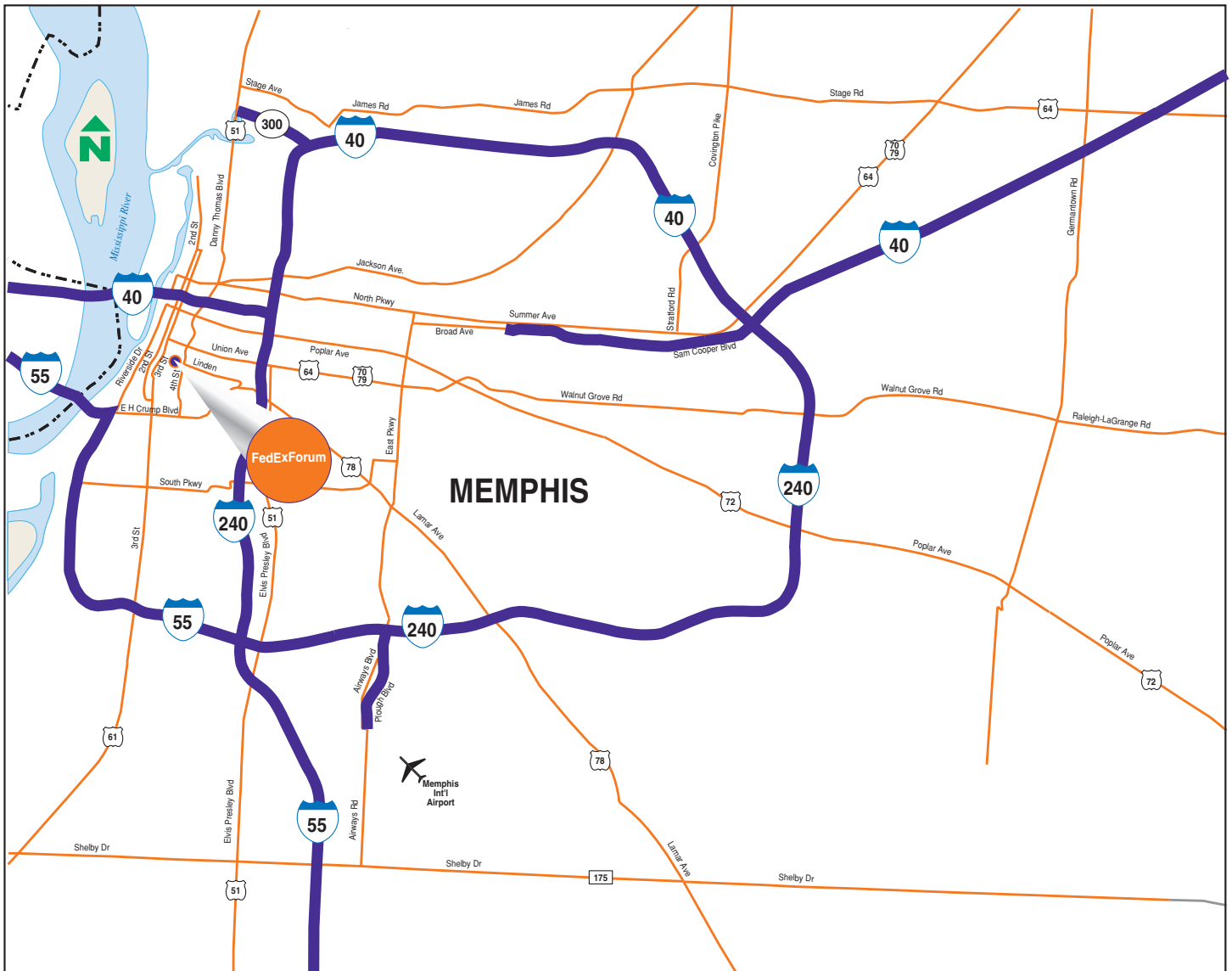
Shuttle Service: The Memphis Area Transit Authority plans roundtrip shuttle service from suburban locations to FedExForum for Memphis Grizzlies and University of Memphis Tigers games. The shuttles begin a staggered departure schedule 90 minutes before tip off and return immediately after the games. Fares are \$5 per person. A 14-game pass is available for \$35 and a full-season pass for \$100.

Parking Study Finds Spaces All Around Arena

There are more than 5,400 parking spaces within a quarter mile of FedExForum and nearly 13,000 parking spaces within a half-mile of the arena, according to a recently completed inventory. That is far more than the 8,300 spaces required for a typical game night at the home of the Memphis Grizzlies and the University of Memphis Tigers. Here's a look at FedExForum area parking options.

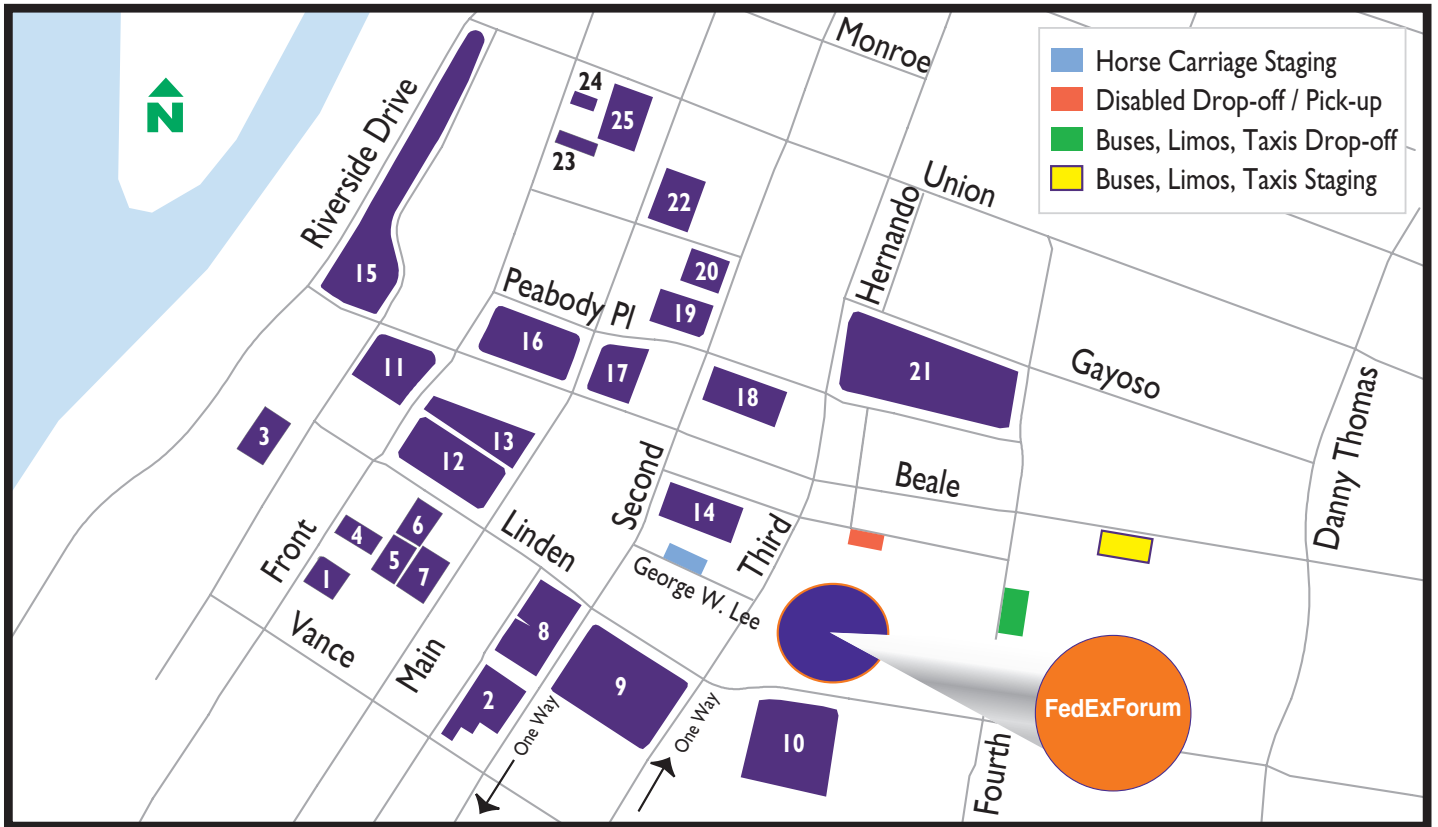
Suggested Routes: From the South, I-55 to E. H. 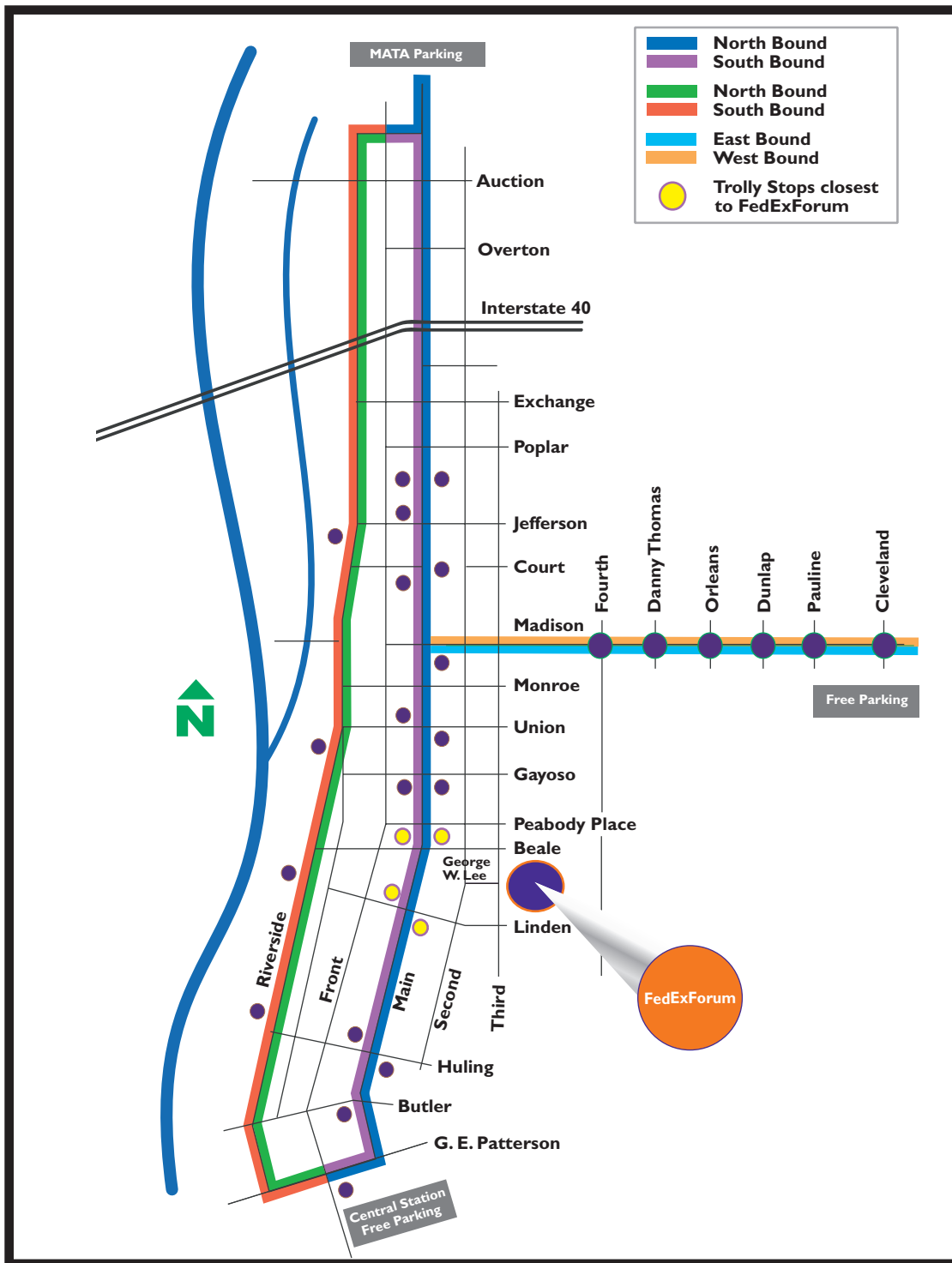

Taxis, Limos, Carriages Add to Transportation Mix

Fans and event-goers who arrive at FedExForum via taxi, limo or express shuttle bus are deposited at the east end of the arena on Fourth Street between Beale and Linden. Horse-drawn and other carriages drop off their passengers west of the arena on Third Street. And a specially designated drop-off location for disabled patrons is located on the north side of FedExForum, off the Beale Street alley which can be reached by turning eastbound off Third Street, which runs one-way north.



Trolleys Contribute to the People-Moving Mix for FedExForum

Trolleys on the Main Street Line, on the Riverside Line and on the Madison Avenue Line will help move FedExForum-bound visitors from parking in and around the South Main Arts District, the Pinch District near the Pyramid and free parking at a MATA park and ride lot at Madison and Cleveland to games, concerts and other events at the arena.
